For dessert, enjoy a delicious malted dark chocolate bombe paired with Café Obscura. The prix fixe dinner is \$85 per person; \$115 with beverage pairing.



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Each selection is paired with California wines. Before dinner, set the mood with the Garden Martini, a signature cocktail featuring fresh muddled cucumber, basil, Bombay Sapphire gin, lime and simple syrup shaken with ice.

As a special flourish to the prix fixe lunch and dinner, each table's server will snap a black and white Polaroid for a personal memento of the meal and the exhibition—a timeless takeaway from a photographer's unforgettable show. The exhibition *Herb Ritts: L.A. Style* is sponsored by Lincoln.
